

Pupils' Code of Conduct

- 1. All pupils should arrive at school well rested and having had a healthy satisfying breakfast.
- 2. Pupils should always consider others, behaving courteously at all times.
- 3. School uniform should be worn with pride; this includes the correct attire for sporting activities.
- 4. Girls' hair should be tied with blue hair ties. Boys' hair should be no longer than collar length. Styling products are unacceptable.
- 5. Jewellery is unacceptable for school. Watches may be worn at the discretion of the staff. Religious symbols may be worn discreetly but must be removed for games lessons.
- 6. All pupils should be in school on time so they can prepare themselves for the school day.
- 7. Pupils should have, in school, all the correct equipment they require to aid learning.
- 8. Pupils need to bring a healthy mid-morning snack and a bottle of water.
- 9. Pupils should take pride in our school environment and take care to look after school property.
- 10. All school work should be done to the best of the individual's ability.
- 11. Pupils should walk around the school site taking care to show friendliness and helpfulness to all.
- 12. Pupils should not enter a classroom unless they have knocked and ascertained a member of staff is present.
- 13. At break time pupils should not be in the school buildings unless they have been given permission to do so.
- 14. At the end of all break times, when the bell is rung by a member of staff pupils should stop moving and speaking and then line up when requested.
- 15. Pupils should not leave the school site unaccompanied bur remain with staff until collected by a parent or carer.
